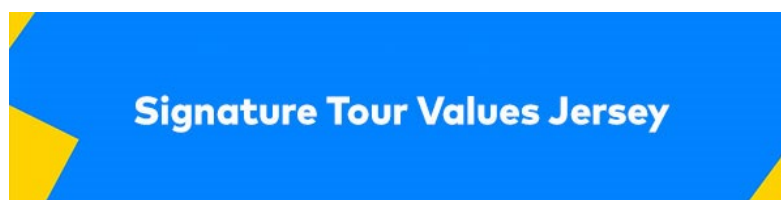

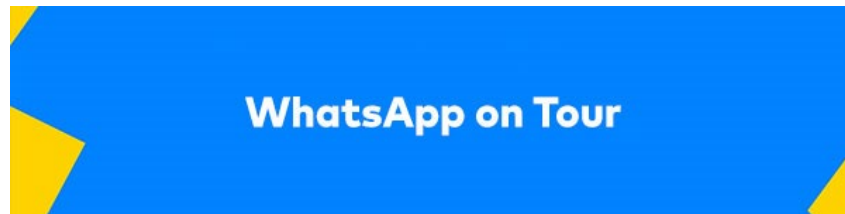
Let's Recap on Tour Logistics

- Wear your TDC polo or T-shirt to the Day 0 evening event. You'll receive your shirts (either tshirts or polo shirts) in your kit.
- We encourage teams to sit together at the Blundstone Arena dinner on night 0, table hosted by your team captain.
- Check-in 4pm on Thursday at either Hobart Discovery Park or Mornington Hobart Discovery Park.

Hobart Accommodation

- If you assembled your bike after flying with it, please get your bike checked over by a TDC mechanic at the Discovery Park where you are staying.
- Riders: You don't need to bring any spares such as tubes, CO2 etc. The TDC trailer has bike 'stuff' to fix most mechanicals. It's a user pay service, you can settle up with us at the end of each day if you get a flat! However, you must have a spare derailleur hanger and this goes in your day bag each day. Do also bring a small cleaning kit to keep your

- bike running smoothly each day. Chain oil/lube | Wet wipes | Small rag | Small multi-tool kit. If flying, don't have these in your hand luggage!

 - If you have put new cleats on your shoes, you MUST test clipping in and out before Day 1, because new cleats can sometimes be too tight and need adjusting.
 - If flying, put your helmet, bike shoes and lights in your carry on luggage, just in case your luggage doesn't make it! Also remember no sharps ie tools in your carry on!
