How are Tour de Cure's funds distributed?

Researchers, scientists, medical and support bodies can apply for funding via our annual grant round. Grants are assessed by our Grants Committee who focus on funding grants that can impact the lives of Australians. <u>Read more...</u>

What do we fund?

Tour de Cure funds traditional research projects which include:

- Senior Research Grant worth up to \$200,000
- Young Research Grant worth up to \$125,000
- Pioneering Cancer Research Grant worth up to \$80,000
- Collaborative Grant worth up to \$50,000
- PhD Grant worth up to \$10,000

Where your donations go

We don't take your fundraising and donations lightly. Our funding allocation model meets strict criteria, with due diligence measures at every step of the way. For every dollar we receive:

70.3 cents goes to cancer projects

25 cents is invested in events to generate future income

4.7 cents is spent on essential administration

Tour Checklist

As part of registering for tour you have some things to check off your 'to do' list. These may seem time consuming right now, but they are important to complete your registration. Get this 'stuff' out of the way as soon as you register and then you can cruise into tour without a worry!

Tour Checklist

Please ensure you are up to date with your tour mandatories

- Sign up to the <u>TDC Hub app</u> (Support crew and riders)
- Complete your medical clearance by visiting a GP and upload your signed <u>form</u> to the TDC Hub app (Riders and Support Crew). Medicals are valid for one year from your doctor's visit.
- Upload your Working With Children Check (volunteer application) number and expiry to TDC Hub app (Riders and Support Crew). Apply now, these can take time to process.
- Take out appropriate insurance for training (Riders)
- Completed a minimum of 5 TDC Supported 40km+ rides
- Reach your fundraising commitment by 14 March 2024
